#### Curriculum

## **Subject Intent**

<u>As Writers, we will</u> investigate narrative with a focus on traditional tales. In this unit, we will create our own unexpected endings.

<u>As Readers, we will</u> explore the vocabulary of fairy stories and how we can use this to create emotions in the reader.

As Mathematicians, we will review strategies for adding and subtracting across 10, explore place value to 100, and apply our knowledge to addition and subtraction.

As Scientists, we will learn about and investigate animals and nutrition.

As Geographers, we will examine and explore volcanoes.

<u>As Artists, we will</u> focus on drawing and seek inspiration from other creators.

<u>As Musicians, we will</u> be learning to play a musical instrument with Mrs. Giles from the Shropshire Music Service.

<u>In PE, we will</u> be taking part in invasion games and gymnastics lessons (Symmetry and Asymmetry).

In RE, we will learn about the creation story and investigate what it is like for someone to follow God (Christianity).

<u>In French, we will</u> introduce the children to Modern Foreign Languages (MFL).
