Subject Intent

As Writers, we will answer an enquiry question about the Stone Age and write poetry with a focus on rhyme and conversation.

As Mathematicians, we will learn our 2-, 4-, and 8-times tables and the relationship between them. Additionally, we will begin to touch on measurement (including, length, mass, volume/capacity, money, and time).
