#### Curriculum

#### **Subject Intent**

As Writers and Readers we will learn about the author Anthony Browne. We will be focusing on two of his well-known books 'The Tunnel' and 'Gorilla'. Once we have identified the key features and language patterns of these texts, we will be comparing them.

<u>As Mathematicians</u> we will be developing skills to add and subtract. We will also be identifying subtraction as difference.

<u>As Scientists we will</u> be learning about animals and their needs. We will be looking at habitats, characteristics of different animals and how they have adapted to survive.

<u>As Historians</u> we will be learning about what schools were like in the past. We will be learning about 'sources' and comparing sources from the past to what we have today. We will also be developing our understanding of timelines and the concept of past and present.

As Artists/design technologists we will be designing and creating a 3D chair for 'Baby Bear'.
