

Speaking and Listening Project

Why are rainforests important to us?

Choose and complete at least one of the projects listed below:

Rainforest Diorama

Create a 3D model of a rainforest layer (emergent, canopy, understory or forest floor) using a box and craft materials. Label the plants, animals and key features.

Animal Fact File

Choose a rainforest animal and make a colourful fact file. Include: habitat, diet, interesting features, threats and a drawing or photo.

Rainforest Food Chain Poster

Draw a food chain that shows how energy flows from plants to predators. Include labels and arrows — display as a classroom gallery.

Mini Documentary Script / Story Board

Plan a short documentary about the rainforest. Write a script or create a storyboard showing scenes, narration and facts children *could* film.

Persuasive Leaflet

Create a travel leaflet to encourage people to protect rainforests. Use persuasive language, pictures and facts about why rainforests matter.

Habitat Comparison Chart

Make a Venn diagram or comparison chart that shows similarities and differences between rainforest and your local environment.
