Curriculum

Subject Intent

As Writers and Readers, we will learn about the story ‘ The Pirates Next Door’ and will be focusing on writing a recount based on the book. We will also be looking at shape poems.

As Mathematicians we will be continuing our work on multiplication and more formal methods of recording. The children will be using their knowledge of multiples to complete given calculations.

As Scientists we will be learning about plants. We will be building on our prior knowledge of what plants need to grow and thrive in our local environment. We will also be looking at identifying different plants and trees.

As Historians we will be learning about how man came to fly. We will be focusing on the famous pilot ‘Amelia Earhart’ and looking at her incredible achievements.

As Artists/design technologists we will be exploring a range of media and focusing on ‘Super Heroes’.

As Musicians our topic is ‘Space’ and we will be learning about contrasting dynamics.

In PE the units that we will be doing a unit on dance and also working on throwing and catching techniques.

In RE we will focus on the Christian celebration of Easter.

In RSE we are looking at citizenship, which includes looking at British Values and how we can implement these within our class.
