Subject Intent

As Writers, we will explore character and setting descriptions, making use of personification and subordinating conjunctions.

As Readers, we will study a range of myths and legends, including 'The Twelve Labours of Hercules'.

As Mathematicians, we will continue to learn the properties of shapes and focus on column subtraction.
