Subject Intent

As Writers we will use exclamation marks to create exclamation sentences and use commands in our writing inspired by traditional tales.

As Readers we will read and appreciate traditional tales such as The Gingerbread Man, Little Red Riding Hood and Jack and the Beanstalk.

As Mathematicians we will explore addition and subtraction strategies within ten, increasing confidence and fluency with number bonds.

As Scientists we will continue to explore animals, this time with a focus on comparing and grouping animals based on their characteristics.

As Historians we will explore the history of toys by making comparisons between toys in the past and present.

As Designers we will design, make and evaluate a moving story book using a slider mechanism.

As Musicians we will use fairy tales to introduce the concept of sound patterns and rhythms, using clapping and voices to create rhythmic patterns.

In PE we will focus on improving our agility and hand eye coordination through racket, bat and ball games.

In RE we will continue our learning of the Jewish faith.

In PSHE we will learn about how to keep safe at home and outside.
